AED Plus May Need Software Upgrade

ZOLL Medical Corporation is asking customers whose Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Plus devices have serial numbers with the last six digits below 200000 to perform a software update and submit confirmation to the company. According to a recent press release, ZOLL determined that some batteries do not work properly when used with defibrillators made before February 12, 2009. The previous software did not adequately detect defective batteries, which could result in the machine failing to deliver a shock.
