Kroger and Shell Team-Up for Savings at the Pump

The Kroger Company and Shell Oil are combining forces to offer gas discounts for grocery shoppers. Kroger shoppers could begin getting at least 10 cents off a gallon at Shell stations after buying \$100 in groceries. Customers have three ways to earn points in Kroger stores and there is no limit on the number of points you can earn.

- 1) Spending on groceries (normal exclusions apply) \$100 in groceries= 100 points
- 2) 2) Two non-federally funded prescriptions = 100 points
- 3) Double gift card points (normal exclusions apply) \$50 in gift cards=100 points

Points earned in a given month are available for use through the end of the following month. Customers can use their existing Kroger Plus Card to receive these fuel discounts or visit the Customer Service Department to sign-up. The process at the Shell pump is easy. Before inserting your payment card, follow the screen prompts to initiate the discount process. Insert your Kroger Plus Card, select form of payment and fuel grade, save 10 cents per gallon up to 35 gallons of fuel per purchase. Check your points balance by going to www.kroger.com.
