Team Lawrence Commerce Park Certified “Deal Ready”

Due to teamwork of several entities, including the Chamber, county government, city government, state government and the Lawrenceburg Utility Systems, Team Lawrence Commerce Park has been officially certified as a “Deal Ready” Industrial Site. The certification guarantees the site meets or exceeds the basic criteria required by companies in need of a development ready industrial site. The park is now equipped with gas, water and sewer service. County and city workers are currently creating an access road and local officials have worked to secure state funding for paving the road. “The Chamber is working about twenty projects with three to four of them

being “hot ,” said Chancellor, Chamber CEO. “I’m glad the city, county and utility system partnered to work on the site and I think we’re getting noticed because of it.”
